Air Trek's Executive Management is committed to continue to provide the necessary financial, personal, and other resources to upgrade and maintain a fully functional SMS.

Air Trek's Executive Management is dedicated to maintaining the confidential employee reporting system, which was established at our SMS's inception, to report all hazards, accidents, incidents, and safety issues without fear of reprisal.

As has always been the case, activities involving intentional disregard for FAA regulations, company policies and procedures, illegal activities, and/or drug or alcohol abuse may be subject to disciplinary action.

As a component of the SMS, Air Trek's Executive Management is committed to upgrading, maintaining, and periodically exercising our Emergency Response Procedures and Plans (Page 11 to 16 of the SMS Manual) that provide for a safe and orderly transition from a normal to emergency operations and then a phased return to normal operations as the emergency situation is dealt with.

Air Trek's Executive Management will convey this expectations to all employees through postings, internet via the employee side of the company web sites, company newsletter, and any other means to ensure all employees are aware of the company's SMS, their duties and responsibilities, and our safety policy.

This Safety Policy will be periodically reviewed by Executive Management to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate to the company and its mission.
